

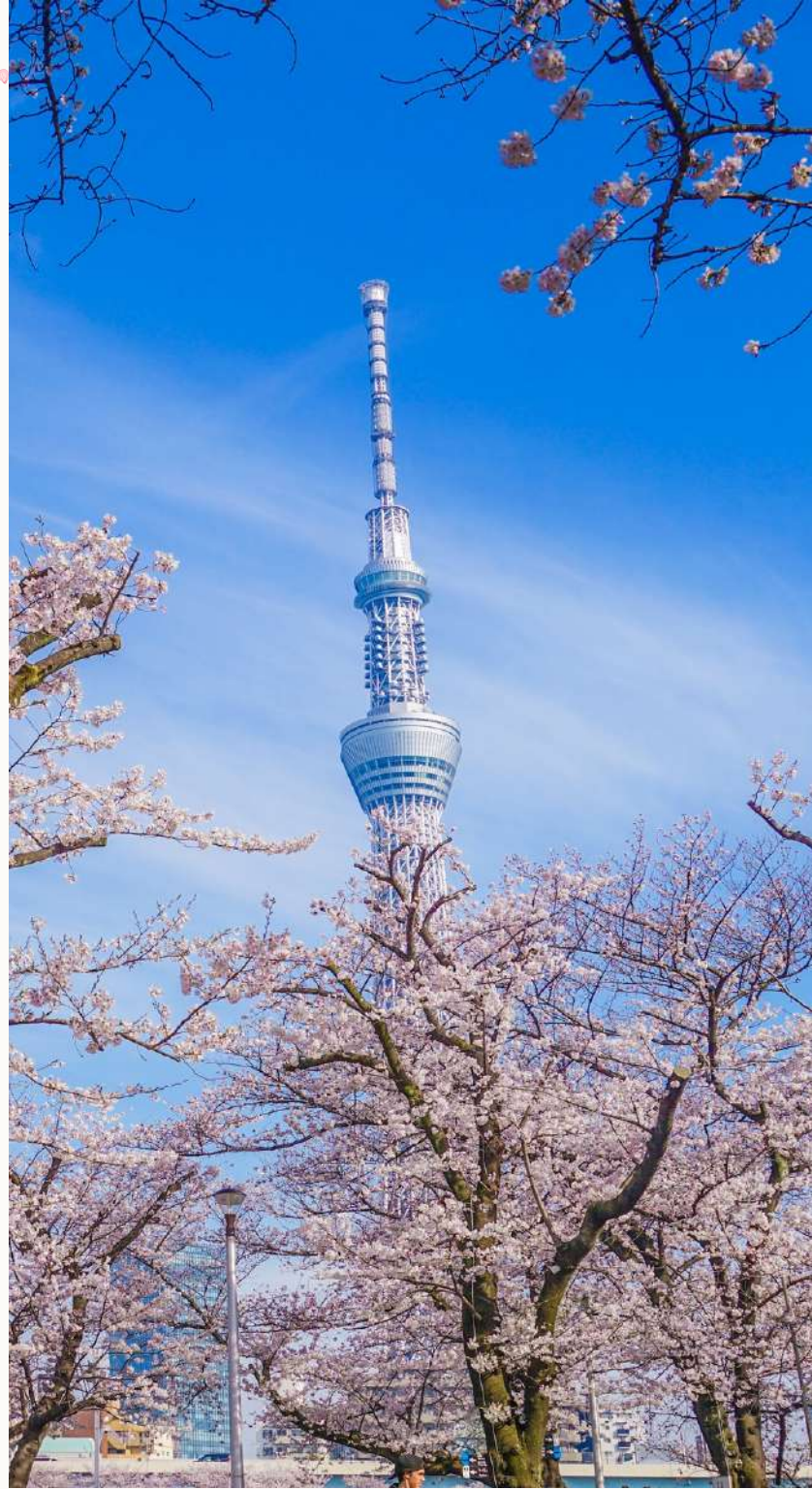


Spring in Japan Enchanting 7-day journey

Day 1: Narita Airport to Odaiba

March 25



After arriving at Narita International Airport (NRT), you will travel to your hotel in Odaiba by chartered bus. Enjoy the night view of Tokyo while soothing your tired body in a comfortable transfer.

Travel smoothly using the toll road, check into the hotel, and enjoy a good night's sleep in preparation for the full-scale sightseeing the next day.

Accommodation: Hilton Odaiba (arranged by customer)



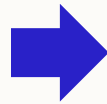
Day 2: Cherry Blossom Tour of Tokyo and Stroll around Asakusa

March 26



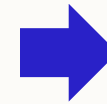
8:30 Departure

Visit the Imperial Palace, a symbol of Japan



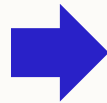
10:45 Ginza

Ginza: A vibrant shopping and entertainment hub



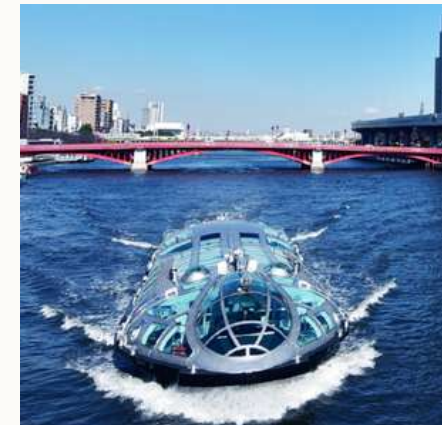
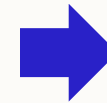
13:20 Chidorigafuchi

Day 3: Spectacular views of Mt. Fuji and Lake Kawaguchi

March 27

From the hotel, you will travel to Lake Kawaguchi by chartered bus and spend the day enjoying the magnificent views of Mt. Fuji and nature.



10:30 Lake Kawaguchi to Mt. Fuji Panoramic Ropeway

The view of Lake Kawaguchi and Mt. Fuji from the summit is exceptionally beautiful.



12:30 Kawaguchiko Music Forest Museum (Lunch)

Enjoy the beautiful European garden and music. Lunch will be served inside the restaurant from 12:30.



14:15 Lake Saiko Healing Village

Saiko Iyashinosato Nemba is a simple village lined with thatched roof houses, exuding the traditional Japanese atmosphere.



Day 4: Move to Kyoto

Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine and Kiyomizu-dera Temple

March 28



10:00 Shinkansen

From Tokyo Station to Kyoto Station (arriving at 12:15) Your luggage will be transported directly to the hotel by chartered transport.

13:30 Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine

Visit the shrine famous for its thousand torii gates. The tunnel of vermillion torii gates is a breathtaking sight. You can also enjoy lunch along the way.

15:30 Kiyomizu-dera Temple

Take a stroll around Kiyomizu-dera Temple, Sannenzaka, Ninenzaka, Hanamikoji, etc. and fully enjoy the atmosphere of Kyoto.



Day 5: Arashiyama, Kinkakuji Temple, and Kyoto Imperial Palace

March 29

On the final day of your Kyoto tour, enjoy a fulfilling program to experience the natural beauty of Arashiyama and traditional Japanese culture.

7:30 Arashiyama Bamboo Forest Path

13:30 Kyoto Imperial Palace

Kyoto Imperial Palace was formerly the Imperial Palace and is home to beautiful gardens and buildings.

10:30 Kinkakuji Temple



This beautiful temple is covered in gold leaf. Its reflection in the pond is called "Kyokochi Pond," and it is one of Kyoto's most scenic spots. Lunch is also available here.

Day 6: To Hiroshima

March 30

Travel to Hiroshima to visit the Atomic Bomb Dome and the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum. Optionally, you can also visit Miyajima.

Optional settings

12:30 Miyajima



Miyajima is famous for its torii gate that stands in the sea, which appears to be floating at high tide, and can be reached on foot at low tide.

Day 7: Transfer to Hiroshima Airport

March 31



**Knot Hiroshima (Hotel) → Hiroshima Airport
by chartered bus**





Cost per person: 113,000 yen (based on 26 participants)

Tour fee includes: Charter bus fare (NRT → Hilton Odaiba, Mt. Fuji tour, Knot Hiroshima → Hiroshima Airport), Shinkansen fare, transportation costs during sightseeing (public transportation)

Lunch on the second and third days, paid facility usage fees, luggage charter transportation fee (Tokyo → Kyoto, Kyoto → Hiroshima), full-day interpreter guide fee (English)



*Optional tour in Hiroshima: 20,000 yen per person (minimum number of participants: 15) Optional tour includes: Charter bus fee (including parking), ferry fee, Itsukushima Shrine admission fee, interpreter guide fee (English)

Payment and Cancellation Policy

Treasure Tourism Co., Ltd.

1. Payment

- ① The application deposit is 20% of the total tour cost and must be paid no later than two months prior to the tour start date. Additionally, payment must be made within three days after the issuance of the invoice for the deposit.
- ② The remaining balance (after deducting the deposit) must be paid no later than 21 days before the tour start date.

2. Cancellation Policy

Period of Cancellation	Cancellation Fee
(1) 21 days or more before the day of departure	Planning Fee (JPY 3,300 per tour day)
(2) 20 days (10 days for day trips) before the day of departure	20% of the tour cost
(3) 7 days before the day of departure	30% of the tour cost
(4) The day before the day of departure	40% of the tour cost
(5) The day of the tour (excluding (6))	50% of the tour cost
(6) No-show or cancellation after tour start	100% of the tour cost

Note:

- 1. Payment processing fees for the tour cost (including deposit and balance) and cancellation fees are the responsibility of the customer.
- 2. All dates and deadlines in this policy are based on Japan Standard Time (JST).
